Advantages of FUZE versus traditional glue application

- **Zero joint** between the board and the edgebanding;
- **Sealed** from microbial contamination;
- **25-year warranty applies to edgeband delamination**;
- Surfaces are **easier to clean**, which is the best way to eliminate viruses;
- **Greater resistance** to moisture and impact.

Conditions and exclusions*

- **All furniture parts must be square or rectangular-shaped**;
- Concept 70 furniture with 71 or 72 textured edges cannot be made with a laser edge;
- A **4% upcharge applies to the list price** for each individual product made with the laser edge technology.

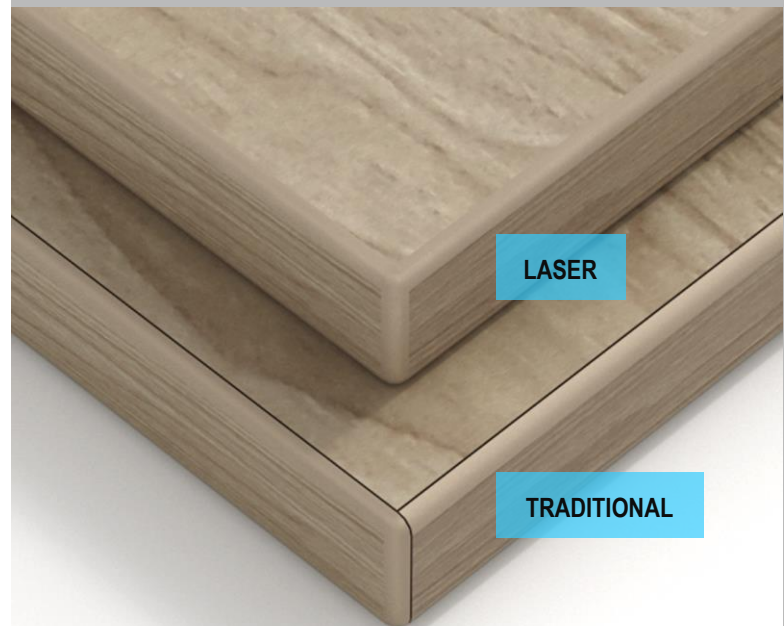
