

Disassembly Instructions For Lounge Seating

1. Remove legs:
 - a. Flip the seating unit over.
 - b. Unscrew the legs from the structure.
 - c. Remove the plastic glides from the legs.
2. Disassemble the seating unit:
 - a. Remove the dust cover under the seating unit by removing the staples.
 - b. Remove the outer back by inserting a flat-blade screwdriver between the back and outer back.
 - c. If the unit has armrests, unscrew the armrests from the structure.
 - d. If the unit has electrical modules, remove them from the structure.
3. Sort each component according to material:
 - a. Remove the staples and pull the fabric out.
 - b. Remove the polyester and foam backing from the wood structure.
 - c. Remove the staples and remove the base fabric from the structure.
 - d. Remove all visible parts until only the structure remains.
4. Check with your local recycling center to find out if the materials are recyclable (varies depending on region/country).
